## Essential Gear Lists for Trekking and Expeditions in Nepal

Climbing above 8000 meters in the Himalayas is a life-changing experience that demands serious preparation. This expedition gear list for 8,000-meter peaks in Nepal is designed for high-altitude mountaineering, such as Everest, Lhotse, or Kanchenjunga.

### Essential High-Altitude Climbing Gear:

#### Expedition-grade down suit (rated -40°C)

- 1) Double-layer mountaineering boots (8000m rated)
- 2) Crampons (steel, compatible with boots)
- 3) Ice axe and jumar (ascender device)
- 4) Climbing harness with safety lanyard
- 5) Helmet (lightweight, impact-resistant)
- 6) Carabiners (locking and non-locking)
- 7) Descender/Belay device (Figure 8 or ATC)
- 8) Climbing ropes (dynamic and static)
- 9) Oxygen system (mask, cylinder, regulator)
- 10) Glacier sunglasses (category 4 UV protection)
- 11) Summit gloves and mittens (waterproof, insulated)
- 12) Base layers (moisture-wicking)
- 13) Fleece mid-layer and down jacket (camp wear)
- 14) Shell jacket and pants (windproof, waterproof)
- 15) Insulated camp boots and socks (multiple pairs)

### Personal & Miscellaneous:

- 1) Sleeping bag (-40°C comfort rated)
- 2) Sleeping mat or inflatable pad
- 3) Headlamp (extra batteries)
- 4) High SPF sunscreen and lip balm
- 5) Water bottles and insulated thermos
- 6) High-calorie energy snacks
- 7) First aid kit with altitude meds
